Main Properties of Licenses

- In decreasing order of importance:
- Commercial use
- Derivative works
- "Share alike" / Source code
- Attribution
- The first three are often show-stoppers, the last can be

Main License Types

- Public domain
- Intrinsic
- GPL/LGPL
- MPL
- BSD
- MIT
- Creative Commons

Public Domain

- Completely permissive
- Virtually no protection from liability
- Must be explicitly dedicated to the public domain
- GDS: can usually use, but should do due diligence and make client aware of use. (**)

Intrinsic

- If no license is specified, then works revert to copyright law. Posted work is inherently protected by copyright.
- No license = no permission.
- GDS: Can't use, contact creator. (****)

GPL

- GNU General Public License
- Commercial projects allowed, but...
- Derivative works must be licensed under GPL
- Full source code must be released publicly
- Non permissive
- GDS: except rare exceptions, cannot use at all (****)

LGPL

GNU Lesser General Public License

- Allows dynamic linking of LGPL licenses in proprietary (commercial) projects - hard to do in AS!
- Must allow users to swap the library
- Modifications to the library must be shared under LGPL or GPL, including subclasses (!)
- Attribution required in source code and documentation
- GDS: Theoretically usable, but technically difficult (***)

MPL

- Mozilla Public License
- Commercial use and derivative works allowed
- Modified code must be distributed under MPL
- Definition of a Modification is permissive: original MPL files or new files containing copied MPL code
- Attribution: must include instructions to get the MPL source code (ex. Read Me, or About screen)
- GDS: Generally quite usable (**)

BSD

- Commercial use and derivative works allowed
- Attribution required in source and compiled (text of license and copyright)
- New (3 clause) and old (4 clause) versions.
 - 4 clause version requires attribution in ALL marketing materials!
- GDS: 3 clause generally usable (**), 4 clause not (****)

Copyright (c) <YEAR>, <OWNER> All rights reserved.

Redistribution and use in source and binary forms, with or without modification, are permitted provided that the following conditions are met:

- Redistributions of source code must retain the above copyright notice, this list of conditions and the following disclaimer.
- Redistributions in binary form must reproduce the above copyright notice, this list of conditions and the following disclaimer in the documentation and/or other materials provided with the distribution.
- Neither the name of the <ORGANIZATION> nor the names of its contributors may be used to endorse or promote products derived from this software without specific prior written permission.

MIT / X11

- Very permissive
- Commercial use, derivative works allowed
- Attribution only required in source code (full license / ©)
- This is what we use to share code publicly
- GDS: Very usable. (*)

Creative Commons

- "Modular" or "customizable" licensing
- Can specify all major clauses, ex. non-commercial, share-alike, attribution.
- Details of attribution is left to the licensor important to check
- Specifically not recommended for source code licensing
- GDS: Usage very much dependent on terms (* ****)
